At the request of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health, Bureau of Substance Addiction Services, the Opioid Response Network is hosting a webinar for individuals working in Opioid Treatment Programs who want to learn more about implementing Buprenorphine in this setting. This webinar will discuss operational, administrative, and clinical aspects of the medication and treatment.

Objectives:

By the end of this activity participants will be able to:

- Understand the policies and procedures of ordering and dispensing BUP in an OTP setting, including key differences between methadone and buprenorphine operations.
- Better understand best practices for buprenorphine use in OTP settings among pregnant and breastfeeding women, as well as the effects of buprenorphine on newborns.
- Increase knowledge about buprenorphine treatment, including best practices for screening, consent to treatment, admission processes, induction, dosing techniques, patient education, and dosing and counseling schedules, as they pertain to OTP settings.
