Overview

SANE Tele-a-palooza online training is part of a 10-hour hybrid didactic training. This online portion covers seven (7) self-paced modules required to complete the 10-hour didactic training. These modules are designed for medical providers interested in providing this forensic-medical assessment and care to adult/adolescent victims of sexual assault. This course will provide RN's, MDs and PAs with a comprehensive education program that meets or exceeds the IAFN's education requirements for the minimal training for evidence collection.

Objectives

1. Apply nursing process, knowledge of rape trauma syndrome and principles of crisis management to the care of persons who have experienced sexual violence.
2. Integrate current legal and forensic standards into the specimen/evidence collection and preservation process when sexual violence is suspected.

Successful Completion

This session offers up to 10 contact hours. Participants must complete all online modules for up to 5.75 CE, the in-person didactic training component for up to 4.25 CE, and the evaluation to receive contact hours. Certificates will be emailed within 4 weeks.
