**Description:**

Dr. Margot Savoy, the Senior Vice President for Education at the American Academy of Family Physicians, will be presenting on the topic of taking an inclusive sexual health history in family planning settings, including with patients of different genders and sexualities, with disabilities, and those needing trauma-informed care.
